The SOUTH PENINSULA INTER-SCHOOL FILM FESTIVAL is brought to you by SAY Media Education in partnership with Forward Fund Academy. It is an inter-school film festival and competition for high schools that facilitates the discovery and development of creative talent amongst senior high school learners. The short films produced as part of the project will be screened at participating High Schools, distributed online and on DVD, and may be broadcast on television and sent to national and international film festivals. Behind-the-scenes footage of the competition and festival process, interviews with the learners involved, and the short films made all form part of an online web series. The themes for the 2018 FILM FESTIVAL is: **ONE IN A HUNDRED** and/or **I AM ENOUGH**

This form **MUST** be completed **IN FULL** and **MUST** accompany every **SCREENPLAY ENTRY** submitted for the competition at the **PITCHING SESSION**. **PITCHING** takes place on 27 July 2018 at **FORWARD FUND ACADEMY**, Solaris Park, (behind Sasol Garage) corner of Kommetjie Road and Lekkerwater Road, Sunny Acres, 7975.

All sections of this form must be completed and signed by the relevant persons. This form must accompany the screenplay when it is submitted. Without this form your screenplay will not be considered. Directions and descriptions must be in English. Scripts should be typed (preferred) or written in screenplay format, Maximum length: 7 pages. If a screenplay does not adhere to these rules it will not be considered by the panel.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF INVOLVEMENT

The SOUTH PENINSULA INTER-SCHOOL FILM FESTIVAL provides an opportunity to learn about and gain exposure in the Film and TV industry. No Learner will be paid for their involvement. All video and audio-visual product produced by the crew during the course of the project (including the short films themselves) will remain the property of SAY Media Education. Video footage including pitches and interviews in which learners appear may be used by the producers in the creation of material related to the Inter-school Film Festival and similar future projects and the Forward Fund Academy. Learners who present their film ideas at pitching, give consent for the public broadcast of these ideas as part of any media created in relations to the inter-school film festival or the Forward Fund Academy. No screenplay received through this process will be produced outside of the SOUTH PENINSULA INTER-SCHOOL FILM FESTIVAL, without the consent and involvement of the writer. Appropriate credit will be given to the school as an institution as well as the learners who are involved. SAY Media Education has the right to market and commercially exploit the films for the purpose of generating revenue to allow the project to continue.
